FUEL WAS CONTAINED BY ABSORBANT PADS, PIGS AND GRANULAR OIL DRY PROVIDED BY CAPTAIN ANTHONY LOVETT WITH CCFR IN INITIALLY CONTAMINATED STORM DRAIN. CONTAINED IN THREE STORM DRAINS IN THE PARKING LOT.

CCWU ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE ARRIVED AT 3:30PM AND MADE CONTACT WITH MANAGEMENT. AT 3:45PM CCWU SCOTT DANIEL NOTIFIED EPD. JOHN MADDOX WITH EPD WAS ASSIGNED FIELD REP FOR THE SPILL.


